The Skybus is an aeroplane that can take up to 19 passengers and flies from Land's End to St. Mary's and takes 15 minutes. You can also fly from Exeter or Newquay airport. It will take an hour. The cost from Land's End for a single flight is £80 and £64 for a child.



The Scillonian is a passenger ferry that sails from Penzance to St Mary's and takes 2 hours 45 minutes. It costs £49.50 for an adult and £25 for a child.
